Richard LeSchander has mastered the Rush catalogue and instrumentation of the legendary master himself, Alex Lifeson. A Rush fan since his earliest days, the piece of gear he's owned the longest is his trusty Gallien-Krueger 250ML, which he bought shortly after his first Rush concert on the 'Hold Your Fire' tour. Rich's main guitars are his Music Man EVH's & Les Paul Standards for classic Rush songs. Rich also built a Hentor Sportscaster clone, like you'll often see in Rush videos from the early 80's...





Rob James started learning to play the drums in 1981, soon after Moving Pictures was released and was being played everywhere. The music of Rush spoke to him and he was hooked! Rob's first Rush concert was at Madison Square Garden, Dec. 2, 1982 on the Signals tour.

Over 40 years later, "with countless hours behind kits rehearsing & performing, I've managed to become moderately proficient at playing Neil's parts of the extensive Rush catalogue..." The Drums Rob uses are Tama Superstar sets and full replicas of Neil's setups from the Permanent Waves & Moving Pictures tours.

Snare: 1960's Slingerland Artist Model Snare with snare bed filed down and wrapped in copper, just like 'Old Faithful' used by Neil. Cymbals: Avedis Zildjians, (1) Paiste and (1) Sabian Paragon.
